Carillon at St. George's Church

Interested in touring a carillon? St. George's church in Guelph is home to one of only 11 carillons in Canada. Originally manufactured in England, this carillon began playing over 90 years ago. It features 36 bells that are played from a special keyboard just below the bells. Four of the bells are also used by a clock mechanism that marks each quarter hour. There will be a short talk about the carillon and of course some real carillon music. Those brave enough to climb the steep stairs will have an opportunity to see the clock mechanism, keyboard and bells in operation.
